54.02	Purpose
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Sec. 54.01 Definitions.

For the purposes of this Chapter:

- (1) "**Electioneering**" means any activity that is intended to influence voting at an election.
- (2) "**Polling Property**" means any building or other facility, either owned or used by the Town, that contains a polling place, including the area located within 700 feet of the perimeter of any such building or facility.

Sec. 54.02 Purpose.

The Town finds and declares that our system of government can best be maintained if the integrity of the election process is maintained and if polling property is not used for electioneering on any election day.

Sec. 54.03 Prohibited Activities.

No person may engage in any electioneering on any polling property on any election day. This prohibition does not apply to the placement, in a conventional fashion, of any material on the bumper of a motor vehicle that is located on such polling property on an election day.

Sec. 54.04 Removal.

The Town Clerk, any election inspector, any law enforcement officer, or any other authorized representative of the Town may remove any posters, signs, advertising, or other material that is placed in violation of this Chapter.

Sec. 54.05 Penalties.

Any person who violates any provision of the Chapter shall be subject to a forfeiture of not less than \$250.00 nor more than \$1,000.000 for each violation.
